The communities from four locations chosen from "peri" urban Karachi, at places mentioned as "urban" probably contributing repeatedly for the organization of the PI. It is would be more appropriate to be inclusive of the urban population of Karachi for a more meaningful outcome rather than ease of data collection. Karachi is divided into number of districts (towns). As prevalence is the goal of the research therefore a more representative samples may be gathered from the of population of Karachi. Same is for district Dadu rural population. A sampling frame for Karachi may be shared as done for the population based epidemiological surveys. 5. IRB approval is still awaited from International Vaccine Institute. It may be shared once received. 6. Is department of Health, Government of Sindh and

Federal ministry of National Health Services & addition of vaccine in the current EPI program can only be made in collaboration with these stake holders. 7. In response to 2.1, what measures shall be taken to

address potential harms to the study subjects?

8. The details about special sub groups is not mentioned in the IRB form. Any reason for omitting such a vulnerable group from the ethics review form?

9. It is mentioned that a standardized questionnaire has been developed. The information

that is to be obtained is not directly related to the study objectives. Why this additional

"research' is being conducted which is not mentioned upfront? There are number of

sensitive questions in that questionnaire as mentioned in detailed document. These

questions are meant for which age group?

10. 4.3.1.4 CSS Procedure (Commercial Sex Workers) -This again is not part of the IRB

form. Selective documentation is not clear.

11. 4.6.1.3 Blood Sample - There is a big "if" about this sample collection. PI probably is not clear about the extent of research. IRB approval is sought before all aspects are addressed.

12. 4.7 Feedback of Results - The reason for not disclosing results to the study participants is questionable. PI approach is expected to be participant centered. Participants are used to provide not only clinical data but also urine and even vaginal samples. They are expected

to be mature enough to understand the results of the tests done on them.

13. It is not clear why participant with persistent HPV infection will be referred to the

"community clinic" and at "discretion of PI". This is a vague approach. A clear protocol

is to be provided. The reason that HPV infection may be asymptomatic may be provided

to the study participants and educate them rather than not disclosing the results.

14. In case of immunocompromised participant, the results should be disclosed upfront and

not at the discretion of PI. An explicit protocol is expected how these study participants

shall receive the "appropriate" clinical services. 15. It will be interest to know if any genital warts are

24. Most of the questions in this section are asked to explore the issue of illicit relationship.

There are number of questions on this single aspect. This needs revision. Number of sex

partners and out of wedlock relations are known risk factors for HPV infection. But this

does not justify so many probing questions.

25. 6A GENDER DYNAMICS AND VULNERABILITY – for girls and women aged 16 years and older - This section may be re visited. There is no mention in the protocol what approaches PI may adopt in such subjects.

This additional aspect of the study, involving genotyping, is a significant departure from the initial impression given by the title. Clarity in the objectives of a research project is crucial for the understanding and interpretation of its findings. If the researchers intend to validate the findings of visual inspection with acetic acid by employing PCR methods for genotyping, this should be explicitly stated in the project's objectives. Moreover, such validation processes should ideally be reflected in the project title to accurately represent the scope and methodologies employed. Additionally, attention should be given to the translation of terms into Urdu. The use of direct transliterations for medical conditions, such as cervical cancer, may not resonate well with Urdu-speaking audiences. It is advisable to incorporate commonly used and appropriate Urdu terms for medical conditions, ensuring that the translation is both accurate and culturally sensitive. Further consent form and patient information sheet should be translated into the regional languages also.
